I. PURPOSE OF POSITION:

Provide musical leadership to the Youth Choir and assistance to the Chancel Choir and Village Community Chorale. To the end that the church might assist people in developing the heart, soul, mind and strength of Jesus Christ through loving fellowship, joyful worship, and self-giving service.

II. ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Attend and sing at:
 - Youth Choir and Chancel Choir Each week
 - Participate in Village Community Chorale, schedule permitting
 - A Sunday morning rehearsal 45 minutes to one hour before service(s)
 - Sunday morning service(s) staying to the end
 - Sing at other services, concerts and recitals as requested by the Director of Music Ministry
- Sing solos or ensembles at the direction of the Director of Worship

- Be enrolled as a full time student.
- Choral experience at the secondary and/or college level

IV. MUSICAL SKILLS REQUIRED

- Must be a proficient vocalist and maintain strong musical literacy
- Must possess good sight-reading skills
- Must possess formal training in music
- Must possess good choral skills, including the ability to follow a conductor, blend with other voices in the section, etc.
